GENERAL RULES
UNIVERSITY STUDIES DANCE CONCENTRATION (DAN)
CATALOG 202031

I. MINORS

University Studies degrees require that students pursue two minors. Students can pick from any of the University approved minors, however, **only one of these minors can be from within the College of Education & Human Development.** Please review the below link for the list of approved Minors offered:

When a course is used to meet multiple graduation requirements (minor & social science course) the credit hours are only counted once. When courses satisfy more than one requirement, the number of elective hours will increase to maintain the 120-hour graduation requirement. Minor 1 + Minor 2 + Elective Courses = 54 of 120 total credits needed to graduate. Minors should be declared before a student hits 75 hours.

II. PROGRESS TOWARDS DEGREE

Student Rule 1.5.1 states, “A student is expected to register for a schedule of courses that follows the program of study for a degree in his or her college. A student who elects not to follow the program of study must obtain approval from his or her academic advisor. A student who fails to obtain approval may be held from registration, removed from the inappropriate course(s) and/or required to register for a prescribed schedule of courses” Periodically advisors will check to make sure you are taking classes towards your degree. If you are planning on changing majors or taking prerequisites for professional school, please let your advisor know.

III. UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PLANNER REQUIREMENT

All students are required by TEC§51.9685 (formerly House Bill 3025) to complete an online undergraduate degree plan once every year until graduation. The Undergraduate Degree Planner and a guide are in Howdy on the My Record tab under the Undergraduate Degree Planner channel. This is not a substitute for advising and approval of your Undergraduate Degree Planner does NOT ensure you are meeting all of the requirements for graduation. The Degree Planner typically opens for submission on March 1st and is due for the Health & Kinesiology by August 1st. The Degree Planner is accessible at any time to plan future semesters. **NOTE:** When students complete 30+ credit hours they will be notified and required to complete and submit their undergraduate degree planner, even if it is their first semester. The degree planner must be approved before you can register for the following semesters courses.

IV. RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

Texas A&M requires that students take 36 hours of upper (300-499) level coursework at TAMU. This is broken down between major coursework (12 hours) and general coursework (24 hours). Major coursework is any 300-499 DCED or KINE course and general coursework can be any 300-499 course. DAN Students will need to take a minimum of 16 additional upper level 300-499 courses as electives in order to meet this requirement; 4 of these 16 hours must be major specific. Consult with your advisor to make sure you meet both the major and the overall residency graduation requirements. See Residency Worksheet in packet.

V. REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

1. Submit departmental *Intent to Graduate* form (<http://mycehd.tamu.edu/>), and *Residency Worksheet* (in packet) by the deadline; **two (2) semesters before graduation semester.**
2. Minimum GPR requirement: 2.0 overall at Texas A&M
3. Complete all degree plan courses with appropriate grades according to your degree plan spreadsheet
4. Apply and Pay Diploma Fee the semester you are graduating
5. Transfer all applicable courses to Texas A&M

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This degree plan has been laid out showing students the number of hours they should take each semester in order to complete the degree in four years. This is a *suggested* plan, students may opt to take their courses differently based on their individual situation. Students should use this document in conjunction with the curriculum spreadsheet, a copy of their degree plan, and meeting with their academic advisor when scheduling courses each semester. Students should be mindful that they need to complete all of the bolded prerequisite courses before they will be allowed to take the shaded upper level KINE courses.
